- Organize training activities and contribute to program development related to Boys Program.
- Monitor and ensure budgets are adhered to in order to achieve the goals of the Boys program.
- Monitor, evaluate, compile reports, and gather necessary documents for internal and external reporting purposes.
- You provide the team in SA and in NL with information, updates, advice and vision regarding the boys program, timely and proactively.
